



- The Institution shall operate only from the approved location, and that the institution shall not open any off campus study centers / extension 8 centers arecity or in collaboration with any other institution / university / organization for the purpose of mparting technical education without obtaining prior approval from the AICTE. If found so appropriate action as per the notified regulations shall be initiated against the Institution.
- The accounts of the Institution shall be audited annually by a certified Chartered Accountant and shall be open for inspection by the Council 9 or persons authorized by it.
- Heads of Departments, the teaching and other staff shall be appointed in given time frame and selection shall be done according to procedures, qualifications and experience prescribed by the Courcil from time to time and pay scales are as per the norms prescribed by the 10 AICTE from time to time. The institution shall publish an information booklet before commencement of the academic year giving details regarding the Institution and courses / programs being conducted, Fees charged and details of infrastructural facilities including faculty etc. in the form of mandatory disclosure. The information tooklat may be made available to the stakeholders of the technical education. The mandatory disclosure information, as per directions in the AICTE website / Approval Process Handbook, shall be put on the Institution Website. The information shall be revised every year with updated information about all aspects of the Institution. 11. It shall be mandatory for the Institution to maintain a Website providing the prescribed information. The Website information must be
- continucusly updated as and when changes take place.
- 12. As per mandatory Disclosure of APH 2024-27 (Annexure-18, page 180) Institutions must disclose the following information submitted to Council at the Prominent location on its website.

 - ii. Additionally, Audited Financial Statements for every Financial year on year to year basis.
- 13. If the Institution fails to disclose the information or suppress and / or misrepresent the information, appropriate action as per the notified regulations shall be initiated against the Institution.
- 14. AICTE may also conduct inspections with or without notifying the datas to verify specific complaints, to verify adherence to AICTE norms & standards, and to verify any mis-representation, violation of norms & standards, mal-practices etc.
- 15. The Institution by virtue of the approval given by Council shall not automatically become claimant to any grant-in-aid from the Central or State Government.
- 16. In the event of a student / candidate withdrawing before the starting of the course, the wait listed candicates should be given admission against the vacant seat. The entire foe collected from the student, after a deduction of the processing lee of not more than Rs. 1000/-(Rupees one thousand only) shall be refunded and returned by the institution to the student / candidate withdrawing from the program. It would not be permissible for the Institution to retain the School / Institution Leaving Certificates in original to force retention of admitted students and not to charge fees for the remaining period if a student cancels the admission at any point of time.
- 17. The institution shall take appropriate measures for prevention of ragging in any form, in the tight of AICTE regulation "Prevention and Prohibition of Ragging in Technical Institutions, Universities including Deemed to Universities imparting technical education" Regulation 2009 (F.No. 37-3/Legal/AICTE/2009 dated 01/07/2009). In case of failure to prevent the Instances of ragging by the Institutions, the Council shall take appropriate action as per the notified regulations.
